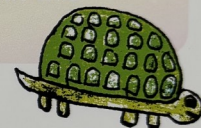
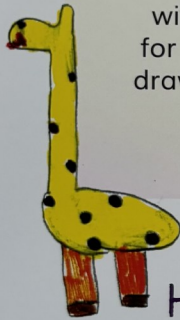


Have fun and keep your kids busy creating their **Perfect Pets** for this national drawing competition!

The map in this leaflet shows easy access routes to the event. It's a short walk, from further out, to avoid this part of Alwyn Road.

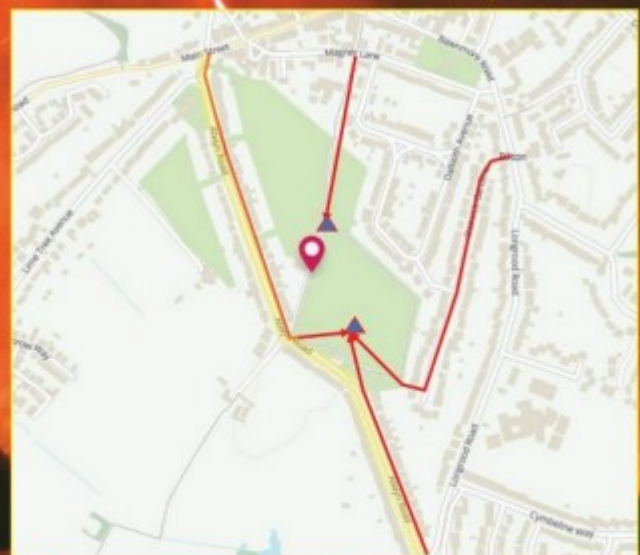
