After School Clubs Spring 2 2025



Some of our clubs are run by school staff and have a cost in order to cover the cost of resources. School staff that run clubs do not get paid to do so which helps to minimise the cost to parents. Children who receive Pupil Premium Funding can access 2 clubs per half term for free (with the exception of Funstar Musical Theatre and Football, STKD Tae Kwon Do and Spellbound Dance Clubs).

Children attending before school and after school clubs must be dropped off and collected on time. Please do not use the school car park when dropping your child off or collecting your child from a club. In order to ensure the children's safety, we would ask that parents wait outside the main school entrance (automatic sliding doors) when collecting from an after-school club.

Refunds will only be given in exceptional circumstances as places cannot be reoffered once a club has commenced.

Clubs will commence week beginning Monday 24th February and run until the Easter holidays although there will only be externally run clubs running during the last week of term (no school led clubs as staff will have Parents' Evenings).

Target Games Club

The club will be run by a coach from Harris School Sports Partnership after school on a Monday from 3.15pm until 4.15pm. The cost is £2.00 per session and there are 16 spaces available, open to all year groups. Target games are activities where children throw an object towards a target to score points. They can help children develop physical and cognitive skills. Activities will include boccia, new age kurling, tri golf, disc golf and archery.



Drawing Club



This club will be run by Miss Bale and Mrs Nevin after school on a Monday from 3.15pm until 4.00pm and is open to all year groups. The cost will be £2.50 per session to cover the cost of resources and there will be 12 spaces available. This club is for all our budding artists. Each week the children will be guided through step-by-step of how to draw something using drawing pencils. We have a wide range of pencil crayons for the children to colour in their finished piece which they will be able to bring home.

Musical Theatre Club

This club will be run by Funstar on a Tuesday from 3.15 to 4.15pm, is open to all year groups and will cost £5.00 per session. Information has been sent out separately about this club. Computing Club

This club will be run by Mrs Wright and Miss Gaskin after school on a Monday from 3.15pm until 4.00pm and is open to all year groups. The cost will be £2.50 per session and there will be 12 spaces available. The children will use the iPads to solve problems, use code, learn IT skills and play games.



Craft Club

This club will be run by Miss Swaden after school on a Tuesday from 3.15pm until 4.00pm. The cost of the club is £3.00 per session to cover the cost of resources and is open to all year groups with 12 places available. The children will be doing a variety of arts and crafts and getting creative!

Multi Skills Club

This club will be run by a sports coach from Harris School Sports Partnership before school on a Wednesday morning from 8.00am until 8.40am. There will be 16 spaces available which are open to all year groups and the cost will be £2.00 per session. The children will take part in different activities and games each week focusing on agility, balance and coordination.





Tae Kwon Do Club

This club is run by a coach from STKD after school on a Wednesday from 3.15pm until 4.15pm and is open to all year groups. The cost is £3.00 per session. The children will learn different moves and techniques every week and learn to challenge themselves. They will have the opportunity to reach a new grade (coloured belt) every term at an additional cost of £35 therefore a commitment to the club is expected.

Spellbound Dance Club

This club is run by a coach from Spellbound Academy of Dance after school on a Thursday from 3.15pm until 4.30pm. The cost of the club is £3.50 per session and is open to all year groups with 25 places available. During the Dance Club children will be able to learn a wide variety of dance styles including; Freestyle, Street Dance, Lyrical, Jazz and so much more!





Science Club

This club will be run by Miss Sanders after school on a Thursday from 3.15pm until 4.00pm and is open to all year groups. The cost will be £3.50 per session to cover the cost of resources and there will be 12 spaces available. Children will be doing lots of hands on experiments that teach different scientific concepts in an exciting way.

Football Club
